

**General Rules and Regulations
Concerning Headstone**

(Subject to Change)

1. Headstone must be granite, except for choice of upright marble gov't marker. Bronze markers are not permitted.
2. Additional headstones may be placed on the back line of lots, space permitting. If the base of a headstone on a lot exceeds 36 inches, no additional stones can be placed on the lot. No corner markers or sills are permitted.
3. Only one headstone is permitted per grave.
4. Base of stone placed at head of a single grave must not exceed 2' x 1', overall height must not exceed 30".
5. Payment in full must accompany foundation order.
6. As a guarantee of good work and as a protection to all lotholders, and for the general welfare of the cemetery, the management reserves the right to excavate for and build all foundations.
7. The Cemetery Company reserves the right to require evidence of insurance or other financial responsibility satisfactory to The Cemetery Company before any work is started in the cemetery.
8. Anything placed on a lot is put there at the lotholders risk, and The Cemetery Company will accept no responsibility for damage to any stone.
9. The Cemetery Company reserves the right to prevent erection of and to remove any monument or other object which might interfere with the general effect or which it deems improper.
10. Additional information furnished upon request.
11. Lots must be placed in perpetual care before the erection of any stonework. Effective 4/15/84.
